

March 31, 2025 – COVID Cases

Dear Residents and Family Members:

It has been some time since we have had to make you aware of COVID positive cases. On Thursday, 3/27/25 one of our residents on our short-term unit 2 North tested positive. We then tested all the 2 North residents on 3/28/25 and we confirmed 7 positive cases.

We have posted signage in the front lobby notifying visitors of the outbreak since Thursday 3/27/25.

Our RN Infection Control Preventionist notified the NYSDOH and we are following the most current guidelines recommended.

On Saturday 3/29/25, one resident on 1 North started showing signs and symptoms of respiratory illness and tested COVID positive. We conducted unit testing on Monday 3/31/25 and two new cases were identified.

Both 1 North and 2 North units are closed. Activities and communal dining are suspended on these units until further notice. Visiting is not restricted, however you are encouraged to wear a mask and practice frequent hand washing at a minimum before and after your visit.

As of this afternoon (3/31) we have a total of 12 cases in the facility.
