July 16, 2024—Covid Positive Residents

Dear Residents and Family Members:

As reported last week, LCC has been impacted by the summer resurgence of the new highly contagious Covid variant. Over the last several days, we continued to conduct contact tracing of residents on the affected unit. During the proactive testing, more residents tested positive, bringing the total number of residents to 15. The NYS and local Departments of Health have been notified of the new cases. The symptoms of a number of those residents continue to improve, and they are approaching the completion their ten day isolation period. They will be cleared on Day 11, using the date the individual tested positive as Day one. Contact tracing testing will be conducted as per CDC and NYS DOH guidelines.

While we remain open to visitors, if you do choose to visit, we strongly urge you to wear a well-fitted mask and to stay current with your vaccines. Again, we would like to remind you that after leaving Unit 1 North, please exit the building immediately and do not go to any other areas of the facility. If you prefer to postpone your visit until this outbreak resolves, please take advantage of our virtual visitation options to stay connected.
